

RoHS (2) Compliance Statement – Fibercore Limited

Fibercore is fully aware of the requirements under the **Restriction of the use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2012 (as amended)**, which came into force on the 2nd January 2013 and implements the **European Parliament and Council Directive 2011/65/EU (“RoHS 2”)**.

Fibercore products do not fall within the scope of the Directive and therefore Fibercore is not required to comply with the provisions of RoHS 2. Fibercore can confirm that its products:

1. do not contain any of the 10 restricted hazardous substances (Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated biphenyls, Polybrominated biphenyl ethers, bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), dibutyl phthalate (DBP), and diisobutyl (DIBP) as listed under Annex II of the Directive.
2. do not contain any electrical or electronic component and therefore does not require to make an EU declaration of conformity or affix the CE mark to our products in accordance with regulations 12 and 16.

Fibercore will continue to monitor any new amendments/ changes to the Regulations and subsequently review its position with regards to compliance. Fibercore will also ensure that any new information is communicated to its customers, suppliers and stakeholders as required.
